**Eligibility Standards:** NBACF Flood Relief Fund grants are available to individuals, families, and businesses in the North Bend Area.

**Grant expenditures:** The purpose of the NBACF Flood Relief fund is to help with financial needs of North Bend area residents and businesses who suffered losses or damages from the recent flood. Examples of eligible expenditures might include – but are not limited to – the following: *Equipment, materials and services necessary to make homes livable, businesses functional and not covered by insurance, FEMA or other relief assistance; rent, hotel/motel or other short-term living expense; home/business repair, equipment and materials; mold abatement materials and services; replacement of home/business equipment and materials; replacement of food, clothing, and other necessities; replacement of personal materials, job-related travel expenses, counseling services, and miscellaneous materials, services or other expenses not listed above.*

**Description of Needs:** Please describe uncovered losses or expenses for which you are seeking a NBACF Flood Relief Grant. Documentation and copies of receipts would be key in determining the qualifying amount of grant. Although previous recipients may apply, priority will be given to residents who have not received flood relief assistance. We ask applicants to keep in mind that these funds are sent by volunteer donors who sincerely seek to help families and businesses in the North Bend Area recover from flood related losses. Please note NBACF Flood Relief Funds cannot duplicate FEMA assistance, insurance claims paid, or other relief assistance.

**Additional Information:** Please share additional information you feel will be helpful to the Committee in calculating uncovered losses and continued needs resulting from the flood.
