A \$10,000 Match Challenge focused on supporting efforts to improve the Killian Cemetery, (the Czech Cemetery Association). Through this challenge, the community rallied together and raised \$22,650 through the North Bend Area Community Foundation, with additional donations going directly to the Czech Cemetery Association.

A Community Match Challenge like this is an incredible way for each contribution to have an even greater impact, and it's a meaningful approach for donors who want to amplify their philanthropic




goals. Thanks to this collaborative effort, the foundation and our community made significant progress toward enhancing a cherished part of our local heritage.
